# Ndutu Wildebeest Migration & Zanzibar Beach Sky of Serengeti Safaris

#### **TOUR SUMMARY**

Tanzania offers the finest Game viewing opportunities in Africa and this exciting photographic tour visits the most outstanding of these wildlife locations: Ndutu Ngorongoro Conservation Area, the amazing Serengeti and the unbelievable Ngorongoro Crater. In January, February and April the vast Serengeti National Park is home to huge herds of wildebeests when more than 5,000 calves are born every day! Each year over 1 million wildebeests and 300,000 zebras migrate up to 1,000 kilometers following ever changing food and water supplies. After the short rains the southern Serengeti plains are a rich food supply as new grass is stimulated to grow, providing the migrants with the nutrition essential for successfully rearing their young. Alongside the wildebeests and zebras will be many thousand Thomson gazelles who have similar but shorter annual movements. With so many herbivores, their predators will be close by. We hope to see all the big cats, lions, leopards and cheetahs. Spotted hyenas, jackals and vultures will be present in large numbers feeding on the carcasses.

#### **ITINERARY**

#### DAY 01: KILIMANJARO (JRO) ARUSHA, TANZANIA

Arrival, Meet our Sky of Serengeti Safaris representative and Driver/ Guide. Pickup from Point of entry (Kilimanjaro International Airport) (1hr drive). You will be driven in a 4WD Land Cruiser (MIN BUS) depending on group size, in either case the Safari Vehicles are specially designed for Safari with open roofs for game viewing and a guaranteed window seat for each passenger. Visas will also be required depending on Nationalities-you can acquire Visas on arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport.

#### **DAY 02: ARUSHA / TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK**

Breakfast at the lodge. After your breakfast drive Tarangire National Park with picnic lunch boxes for a full day game drive (2hrs drive). Tarangire is a beautiful area stretching south-east of Lake Manyara around the Tarangire River. It is the home of giant baobab trees, rolling savannah and acacia parkland. Tarangire has one of the highest concentrations of wildlife which include elephants, large herds of zebras,



wildebeests, hartebeests, elands, lesser kudus, gazelles, giraffes, waterbucks, impalas, sporadic leopard and a variety of Birds. Tarangire is part of an extended ecosystem where animals roam freely. It includes the large Mkungunero Game controlled area to the south and the Lolkisale Game controlled area to the north-east.

#### **DAY 03: TARANGIRE / NDUTU KATI KATI**

An early breakfast will be taken at the camp, and a picnic Lunch will be carried, getting ready for a long drive to the Ndutu Ngorongoro & Serengeti plains (4hrs drive). En route you will drive through the Maasaï country side passed the Rift valley escarpment where you will stop for panoramic views of the spectacular Lake Manyara escarpment, continue through the Agricultural township of Karatu into the Ngorongoro Highlands then to Olduvai Gorge where you will un-pack your lunches while listening to Lectures from a resident Archaeologist at the Olduvai Gorge - rediscovering the fossils of the early man, you will also have chance to visit the Palaeontology Museum where the Australopithecus Bosei skeleton was discovered dating million years ago. Continue into the Ndutu Plains with very brief game viewing as it will be approaching sunset.

#### DAY 04: NDUTU KATI KATI KATI / FULL DAY GAME VIEWING

Early morning and afternoon game drives. At this time of year the extensive herds of wildebeests and zebras are present in the Ndutu area. The Wildebeest migration is one of the greatest wildlife spectacles in the world, numbering over a million animals. Moving together with the Wildebeests are more than a quarter of a million zebras, truly an incredible sight. In the evening we can enjoy drinks around the campfire as the darkening sky silhouettes of African Acacia trees.

#### **DAY 05: NDUTU KATI KATI / FULLDAY GAME VIEWING**

Again we will have early morning and afternoon game drives in the Ndutu Serengeti Areas. Sometimes the wildebeests and zebras pass right through the Camp grounds, as do lions and other wildlife. Some guests prefer to stay right at the Camp to enjoy such happenings and our guests are most welcome to do so if they wish.

#### **DAY 06: NDUTU KATI KATI / SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK**

This morning after your breakfast, depart to the Serengeti National Park with picnic lunches (1hr dive). You will stop at Simba Kopjes or Gol Kopjes for your lunch. Symbol of African Wildlife, the word Serengeti comes from the Maasaï language meaning Endless plains. With 5,900sq mile (14,763km), the Park is inhabited by more than 2 large millions of animals including more than a million wildebeests and zebras, and Thomson gazelles. Large predators including lions, cheetahs, leopards and hyenas are drawn to the area by this abundance of preys which migrate throughout the park and many smaller animals Rock hyrax, But eared foxes, mongoose, Honey badger and jackals.

#### DAY 07: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK / FULL DAY GAME DRIVE

Breakfast at the lodge. During your stay in Serengeti you can decide with your Driver guide how you would like to spend your day: on most mornings you will be awakened early and after coffee or tea depart on an early morning game drive in the amazing Serengeti. The early mornings are magical in the Serengeti when the wildlife is just waking up to great the day. After retuning to the lodge for a hearty breakfast you can depart on a late morning drive returning to the lodge for your hot lunch or you may want to spend the whole day in wildlife game viewing across the Serengeti plain where you will find Kopjes-massive boulder islands in sea of grass.

#### **DAY 08: SERENGETI / NGORONGORO CRATER TOUR**

Breakfast at the camp. Today your Safari starts with the drive to Ngorongoro crater for afternoon have a full-day game drive with picnic lunch boxes (4hrs drive). The Ngorongoro Crater at 2,280m above the sea level, is the largest unbroken caldeira in the world. Surrounded by rare steep walls rising 610 meters from the Crater floor, this natural amphitheatre covers an area of about 250km (100sq miles) and is home to up to 30,000 animals almost half of them zebras and wildebeests. There are also gazelles, buffalos, hartebeests and Black Rhino. Such vast number attract predators mainly lions and hyenas but also cheetahs and leopards. More then 100 species of Birds not found in Serengeti have been spotted here.

#### DAY 09 :NGORONGORO / LAKE MANYARA HALF DAY GAME DRIVE+ ACTIVIETS

After early morning breakfast drive into the jungles of Lake Manyara National Park (1hr drive): Lake Manyara is famous for its tree climbing lions, large schools of hippos at the Hippo pool and the Maji moto hot springs. Set aside by the Park Authorities and then continue exploring the Lake Manyara jungles, where a good list of wild life will be added to your previous record. At 12 30 drive to mto-wa-mbu village for you local hot lunch and activities with our local guide. After hot lunch, Will pick you up from the place where you will have your lunch and walk around the village. You will see a variety of things from rice cultivation, banana plantations, traditional wood carving from Mozambique, paintings to getting to see how the local banana beer is made.

#### DAYS 10-11-12-13-14: LAKE MANYARA / ARUSHA / ZANZIBAR-THE SPICE ISLAND

After breakfast we drive to a nearby Manyara Airstrip (15 m), where we say good bye to our naturalist Drive guide and board our flight to Zanzibar. On the way to the Airstrip, we will stop at an indoor market, where artisans from throughout Tanzania sell their work. This is a great place to purchase batik fabric, fine wood carvings, and even Tanzanite. Arrive at Zanzibar Airport and transfer to La Madrugada South

#### **ZANZIBARI SOUTH EAST**

Relax and enjoy the beaches of Zanzibar. There is a wide range of water sport activities you can do, like snorkeling, scuba diving, boat trips and more. The settlement of Makunduchi lies in the far south east of the island. The town is, besides Stone town, the biggest of Zanzibar with a population of approximately 12,000 people who principally survive on fishing and seaweed farming. Despite the beautiful setting of this small town with its long white sandy beaches, there is very little tourist activity in this part of Zanzibar. Makunduchi is famous for the Mwaka Kogwa festival which takes place over four days in July. The location is great for the people love the natural and traditional Zanzibar village. The 3 kilometer long white sand beach perfect for walking, running, relaxing, and exploring... It is ideal for family, for friends, and romantic couples. Not recommended for people who search an exiting night life. The location is perfect not only for all sorts of beach activities, but also an excellent base to explore other activities like Stone Town (for shopping & history), Dolphin tours and Jozani Forest National Park.

#### **Our Safari Vehicles**

Sky of Serengeti Safaris Ltd uses Toyota Land cruiser 4WD which have been specially built for game viewing and photography. Each vehicle has ample seating, with seat pockets, reference books, binoculars, bottled water, First-aid kit and a cool box for refreshments. Our vehicles have been specially converted for maximum space and comfort including ample space for luggage.

Each vehicle has an open roof and large sliding windows to make viewing and photographing easier during safari Game drives. Each vehicle is equipped with a 2-way HF radio controller for convenient communication between our drivers and our base at any time. A window seat is guaranteed to each passenger. Each vehicle has at least 2 spare tires. To ensure reliable performance from our safari vehicles, an inspection is carried out before every safari.
